The idea of a Rotary District 330 Foundation was initiated by District Governor Dr. Philbert S S Chin of the Rotary Club of Singapore in 1983/84. It was incorporated as a company limited by share capital on 24 September 1985. When District 330 was split by Rotary International into two districts – D3300 and D3310, Rotary District 330 Foundation was split into Rotary Foundation Singapore and Rotary Foundation Malaysia.

On 14 November 1991 Rotary Foundation Malaysia (ROTAFOM) was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee to serve all Rotary Clubs in Malaysia. (including Malaysian Rotary Clubs in District D3310). The Rotary Clubs in Singapore formed the Foundation of Rotary Clubs (Singapore) Ltd. On 12 December 1997 Rotary Foundation Malaysia was renamed Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia.

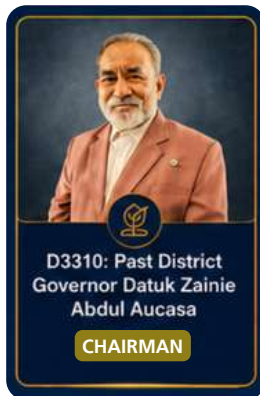
Vision

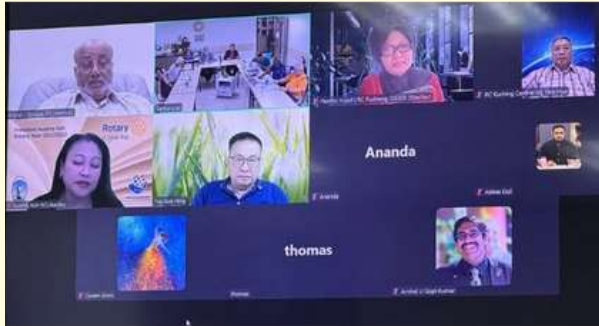

Project Highlights

Board Confirms Grants and Future Priorities



The 134th Meeting of the Board of Directors of Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia concluded on 11 May 2025 with renewed direction and priorities for the year ahead. Grants were confirmed to support impactful initiatives in education, social welfare, sustainability and other community needs, reinforcing Yayasan's continued commitment to Doing Good in Malaysia.

Save The Heart Connects B40 Patients to Life-Saving Care

The Rotary Club of Shah Alam launched the Save The Heart Project on 3 August 2024 through a partnership with Sunway Medical Centre. Since then, four rounds of heart screenings have been conducted, identifying individuals with varying levels of cardiovascular risk.

With Sunway Medical Centre now participating in the Selangor State Government's Selcare Programme, high-risk patients can receive funding support for essential treatment, including angiograms, angioplasty and long-term medication. Five individuals requiring urgent intervention have already been identified and are being assisted in accessing care.

This Selcare, Sunway Medical Centre and Rotary partnership ensures that B40 communities receive not only early screening, but also a pathway to timely, potentially life-saving treatment.



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BADMINTON FRIENDSHIP GAMES Champion AED Awareness

The Bandar Utama Badminton Friendship Games brought together 60 players at Premfield Badminton Court for a day of sport and fellowship.

Gracing the event, Bandar Utama Assemblywoman YB Jamaliah Jamaluddin highlighted the importance of installing Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) at sports complexes.

PAG Lily Lee and Raymond Chee also showcased AED units supplied by Medants Technology Sdn Bhd and installed at the BU3 and BU11 Community Halls under the Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia District Grant AED Project.



Six UTAR Students Awarded Scholarships

Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia, in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Pudu, awarded scholarships to six deserving Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman students, supporting their pursuit of a brighter future through education.

The presentation was attended by Club President Benjamin Chong Yan Khiong, Yayasan's Deputy Chairman PDG Teoh Kwan Swee, Trustee PDG Dr Paul Lee, and members of the Rotary Clubs of Pudu and Hartamas.



COMMUNITY SUPPORT GRANT Water for Life Reaches Kg Pisang



The Water for Life project brought essential water support to the Orang Asli community of Kg Pisang through a collaboration with Idris Club Kuala Kangsar, supported by Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia under its Community Support Grant.

Life-Saving Medical Equipment for Bintulu Hospital



The Rotary Club of Bintulu donated a defibrillator and portable patient monitor worth RM36,800 to Bintulu Hospital, strengthening its capacity to provide critical emergency care. The RM26,800 defibrillator was funded by Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia, while Amalgamated Plant Engineering Sdn Bhd sponsored the RM10,000 patient monitor, which tracks vital signs including ECG, blood pressure, respiration, oxygen levels and heart rate. Club President Geling Ganyai said the contribution reflected Rotary's commitment to addressing urgent community needs and improving patient care through Service Above Self.



Driving Home the Road Safety Message

The Rotary Club of Bandar Sungai Petani, with support from Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia, collaborated with JKJR and JPJ to promote road safety awareness. Club members joined enforcement officers in distributing goodie bags to motorists at a PLUS Highway exit, engaging the community with an important reminder to drive safely.



RYLA 3310 INSPIRES the Next Generation of Leaders

The Rotary Club of Pontian successfully flagged off RYLA District 3310 with approximately 77 participants. Supported by Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia and participating Rotary Clubs, the programme empowers young people with leadership skills, confidence and a stronger commitment to serving their communities.

The units, installed at the BU11 and BU3 Community Halls, were made possible through a collaboration between MBPJ, the Rotary Club of Bandar Utama and Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia.

The Rotary Club of Bandar Utama will also train residents' associations and Rukun Tetangga members in basic first aid and AED use, equipping them to serve as first responders during emergencies. The initiative strengthens public access to life-saving equipment and supports MBPJ's vision of a safer, more resilient Petaling Jaya.
