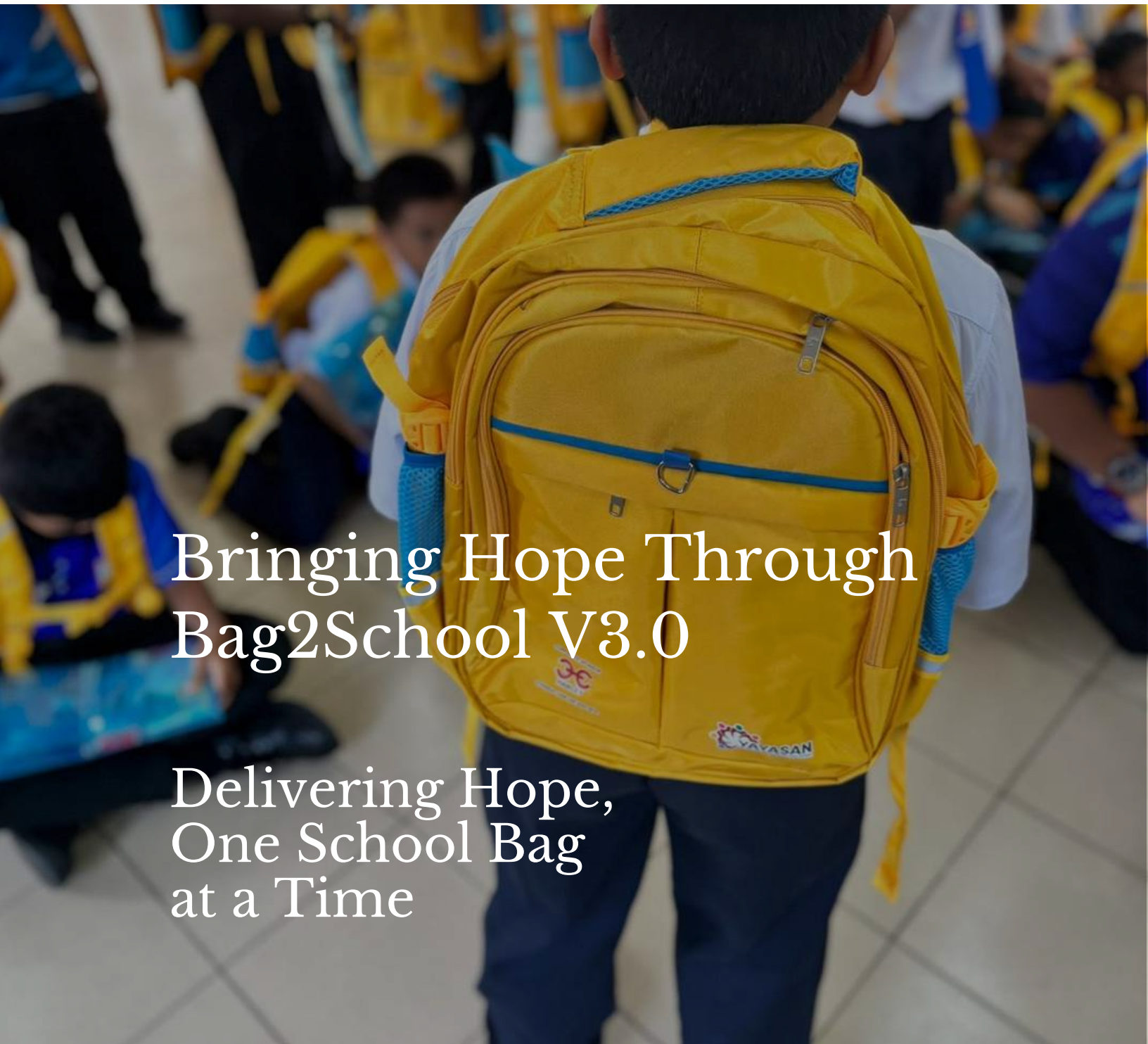

The idea of a Rotary District 330 Foundation was initiated by District Governor Dr. Philbert S S Chin of the Rotary Club of Singapore in 1983/84. It was incorporated as a company limited by share capital on 24 September 1985. When District 330 was split by Rotary International into two districts – D3300 and D3310, Rotary District 330 Foundation was split into Rotary Foundation Singapore and Rotary Foundation Malaysia.

On 14 November 1991 Rotary Foundation Malaysia (ROTAFOM) was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee to serve all Rotary Clubs in Malaysia. (including Malaysian Rotary Clubs in District D3310). The Rotary Clubs in Singapore formed the Foundation of Rotary Clubs (Singapore) Ltd. On 12 December 1997 Rotary Foundation Malaysia was renamed Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia.

Vision

To further the object of Rotary by supporting and supplementing the efforts of Rotary Clubs in Malaysia to better serve the community in poverty alleviation, education, health, humanitarian and disaster relief programs.

Mission

- To be a foundation known to and supported by all Rotarians and Rotary Clubs in Malaysia.
- To support and supplement the funding needs of the district and Rotary clubs in their projects and activities.
- To participate in humanitarian and educational projects that will enhance the public image of Rotary in Malaysia.

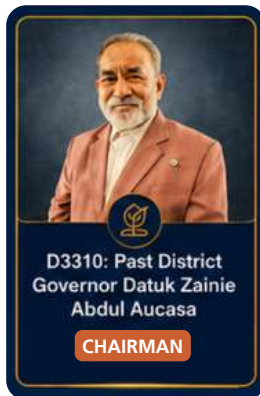

BRIGHT YELLOW BAGS Brighter Beginnings Across Malaysia

Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia's Bag2School 3.0 programme continues to expand its reach, bringing essential school supplies, confidence and hope to students from underserved communities across Peninsular Malaysia and Sabah.

At SJKT Barathy, 20 children received bright yellow school bags presented by Rotary Club President Rtn Rajaram, together with club leaders, the school principal and teachers. Meanwhile, the Rotary Club of Gombak, led by President Ally Chung, distributed another 130 bags to students of PADI with the support of Trustee PDG Leslie Salehuddin, project partners and sponsors including Dutaland Berhad and MH Global Sdn Bhd.

In Sabah, the Rotary Club of Bukit Kiara Sunrise ordered 576 bags, with 288 allocated to students from SK Tiong Widu, SK Kerokot, SK Tinompok Liwan and SK Kumanawan in Tambunan. The distribution brought together students, parents, teachers, PIBG representatives and education officials at Dewan Terbuka Tamu Pahu. YKKRM Chairman Datuk Zainie Abdul Aucasa and District 3310 Yayasan Ambassador Datuk Alex Sham joined the meaningful outreach.

The Sabah Statewide Bag2School 3.0 initiative was officially launched at SK Kokol, led by the Rotary Club of Kota Kinabalu Pearl in collaboration with Rotary Clubs from Kota Kinabalu, Sandakan and Tawau, YKKRM and the Sabah State Education Department. A total of 1,064 bags will be distributed to identified B40 schools throughout the state. During the launch, 276 bags were presented to students from SK Kokol, SK Poring-Poring and SK Tombongon.

The programme also received support from Max Solution (M) Sdn Bhd, demonstrating how corporate and community partnerships can remove barriers to education.

More than a container for books, each school bag carries a powerful message to every child: you are seen, supported and worthy of a brighter future.
