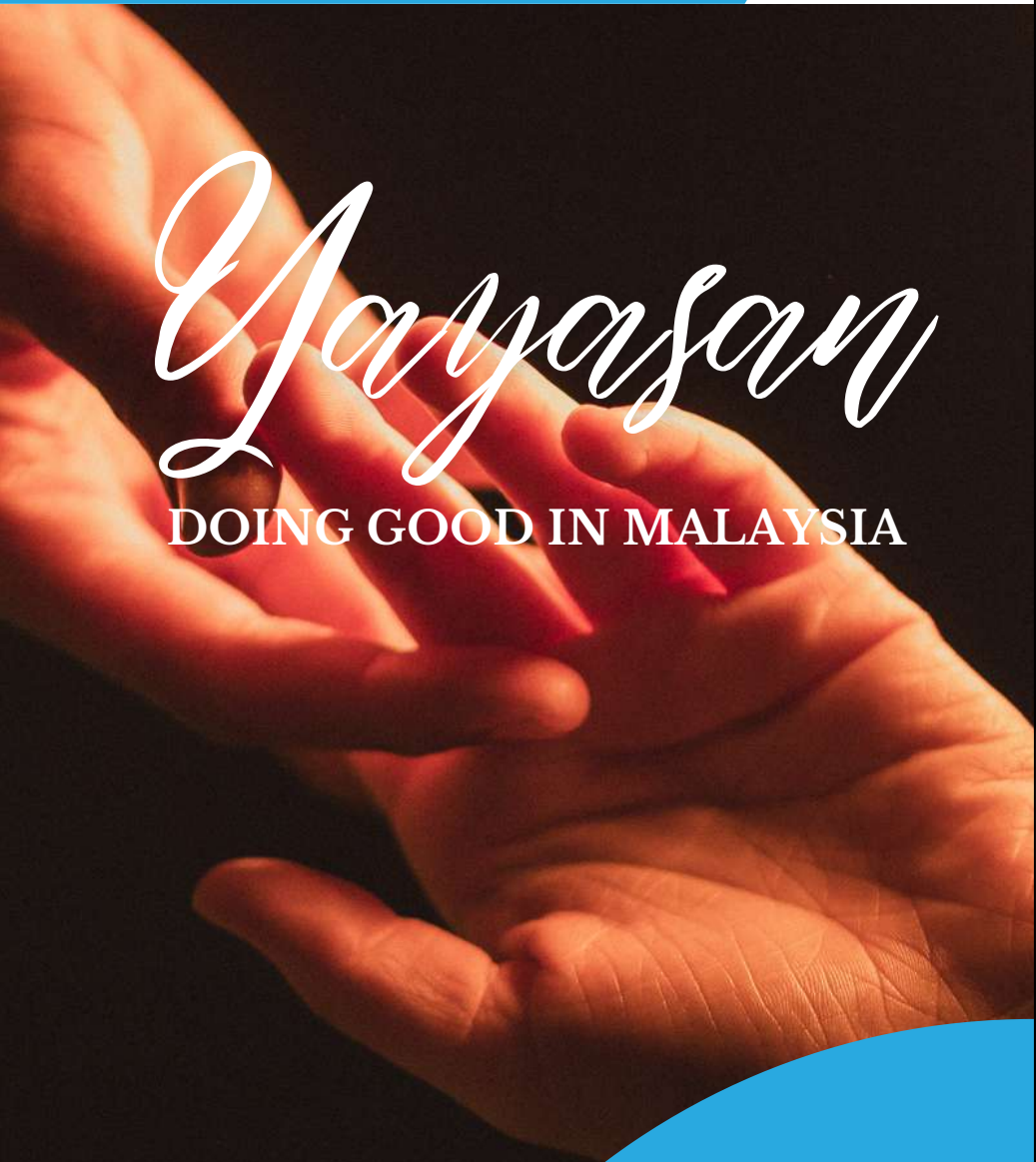

The idea of a Rotary District 330 Foundation was initiated by District Governor Dr. Philbert S S Chin of the Rotary Club of Singapore in 1983/84. It was incorporated as a company limited by share capital on 24 September 1985. When District 330 was split by Rotary International into two districts – D3300 and D3310, Rotary District 330 Foundation was split into Rotary Foundation Singapore and Rotary Foundation Malaysia.

On 14 November 1991 Rotary Foundation Malaysia (ROTAFOM) was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee to serve all Rotary Clubs in Malaysia. (including Malaysian Rotary Clubs in District D3310). The Rotary Clubs in Singapore formed the Foundation of Rotary Clubs (Singapore) Ltd. On 12 December 1997 Rotary Foundation Malaysia was renamed Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia.

Vision

To further the object of Rotary by supporting and supplementing the efforts of Rotary Clubs in Malaysia to better serve the community in poverty alleviation, education, health, humanitarian and disaster relief programs.

Mission

- To be a foundation known to and supported by all Rotarians and Rotary Clubs in Malaysia.
- To support and supplement the funding needs of the district and Rotary clubs in their projects and activities.
- To participate in humanitarian and educational projects that will enhance the public image of Rotary in Malaysia.

These initiatives reflect what is possible when Rotary clubs, partners and individuals unite behind a shared purpose.

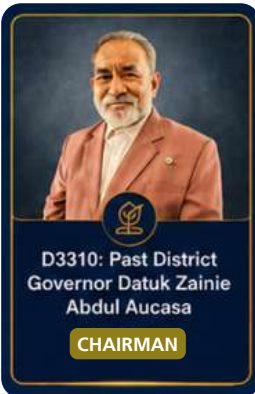

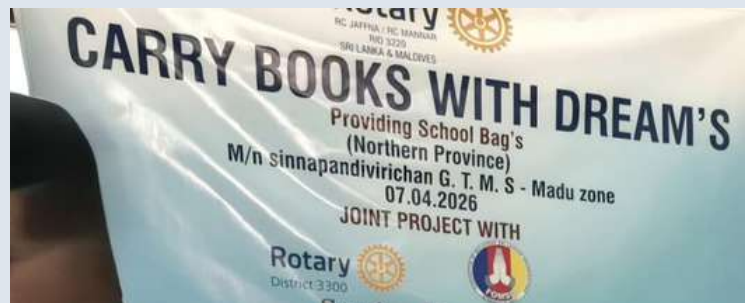
Music Unites Partners in the Fight Against Polio

Proudly supported by Beacon Hospital, the concert raised funds for global polio vaccination and awareness efforts, bringing together Rotarians, supporters and members of the media in the shared mission to eradicate polio worldwide.

Bags of Hope Reach Students in Sri Lanka

Contributing clubs included Bandar Utama, Greater Kuala Lumpur, Kuala Lumpur DiRaja, Lake Gardenia, Cheras and Melawati—demonstrating the strength of collaboration in supporting education beyond borders.



CLIMBING FOR LIFE:

Yayasan Backs Mount Kinabalu Transplant Expedition

Yayasan Kelab-Kelab Rotary Malaysia proudly supported the flag-off of the **Wira Transplant Malaysia Mount Kinabalu Expedition**, a powerful celebration of courage, resilience and life after transplant.

Representing Yayasan was Trustee Audrey Koh. Yayasan reaffirmed its commitment as a partner of the expedition for the third consecutive time. From 6 to 8 May, 35 transplant survivors, doctors and supporters will take on Mount Kinabalu, proving that transplantation offers not merely survival, but the opportunity to live fully and inspire others.

The expedition was made possible through the tireless efforts of Wira Transplant Malaysia and members of the Rotary Club of Melawati, who raised RM200,000 for the initiative. The Rotary Club of Kota Kinabalu, represented by President Jack Lo, also contributed a donation in support of the cause.

Beyond the climb, the event highlighted an urgent national healthcare concern. Malaysia records approximately 27 new dialysis patients and 20 dialysis-related deaths daily.

Participants and advocates called for greater investment in transplantation, the establishment of a dedicated National Transplant Centre and transplant facilities in Sabah, where patients currently face significant costs travelling to Kuala Lumpur for surgery.

Special appreciation was extended to YB Dato' Sr Mohd Ishak bin Datuk Ayob for his unwavering support and commitment to amplifying this critical issue.
